Official Rules

REQUIREMENTS:

- Honey - **two** (2) 1-lb. jars, or **two** (2) sections of comb honey.
- Artistic Beeswax Candles - candle must be beeswax, but non-beeswax enhancements are allowed.
- Beekeeping Arts and Crafts - It can include batik, encaustic painting, collage, mixed media, quilts, painting, knitting, embroidery, and so forth.
- Scenic - Must be a photo of a honey bee yard, truck transporting bees, installing packages, doing a hive check, bee hive removal, swarm trap, or other bee activity
- Beekeeping Gadget - gadgets accompanied with written description of the use and function of the gadget.
- Must be 100% pure honey or 100% beeswax produced by the entrant, except as noted.
- All entries will be included in the raffle or auction to benefit The Beekeepers of Indiana.
- Must be registered and attend the Fall Conference for entry.

ENTRY FORM: Use the accompanying entry form. Photocopies are acceptable.

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per entry. A person may enter as many classes as desired; one entry per class.

DEADLINES: Your entry must be brought to 2022 TBoI Fall Conference Registration desk **by 9 am on Saturday, October 29, 2022.**

CONTAINERS: Entries in incorrect containers may be disqualified.

Classes A-C: 1-lb. Queenline-style or Classic-style glass jars. **(no labels affixed).**

Class D: 1-lb. round chunk honey jar (has small shoulder) or straight cylinder glass jars with standard lids **(no labels affixed).**

Class E: Glass jars, minimum six ounces. **(no labels affixed).**

BEESWAX: **Class F:** Beeswax Candles - Entry may be a single candle, a pair, or a set of candles, which may be dipped, molded, or rolled sheets. **No non-beeswax enhancement is allowed.**

Class G: Artistic Beeswax Candles - Entry may be a single candle, a pair, or a set of candles, which may be dipped, molded, or rolled sheets. **Candle must be 100% beeswax, but non-beeswax enhancements are allowed.**

OTHER:

Class H: Beekeeping Arts and Crafts – The purpose of this category is to allow persons who create any type of art by painting, sewing, knitting or embroidery to show their talents. Exhibitor must submit estimate of time to make item on a card, to be included with the entry (**no labels affixed**).

Class I: Scenic - Must be a photo of a honey bee yard, truck transporting bees, installing packages, doing a hive check, bee hive removal, swarm trap, or other bee activity. Photo must be minimum size 8" x 10". Brief caption must accompany the photograph. Winners must agree to have their photos published by TBoI in any/all appropriate publications.

Class J: Beekeeping Gadgets - Beekeeping gadgets accompanied with written description of the use and function of the gadget. Exhibitors' names must not be shown.

JUDGING:

All entries will be judged according to the official score sheet. After the show, completed score sheets will be available at the registration desk. Each honey entry should be **accompanied** by TWO (2) labels, which will be attached to the entries after judging. Ordinary honey labels showing the name and address of the producer (entrant) and floral source are suitable. **DO NOT AFFIX THE LABELS TO ENTRIES** (as indicated earlier).

AWARDS:

A special award will be presented for each First Place entry. Second and Third Place entries will receive ribbons. If the judges determine that none of the entries in a class warrants a first place, none will be awarded.

RAFFLE:

All entries will be raffled or auctioned during the conference. Proceeds of the raffle or auction benefit The Beekeepers of Indiana. All persons, including the entrants, are invited to participate in the raffle and auction.
